DIRECTIONS:

1. Spray Thermo-Trap Gel on surfaces that need to be protected from open flames prior to soldering, brazing, or welding. The amount required will vary depending on the temperature of the heating tool, and the length of time the heat is applied. The longer the duration the flame is needed, the thicker the coating of gel should be. Remember, too much Thermo-Trap can't hurt, but too little could.
2. Be sure Thermo-Trap Gel completely covers the surface or area to be protected from the open flame.
3. After the job has been completed, just rinse off the Thermo-Trap Gel with plain water or wipe off with a damp cloth.

CAUTION:

Even though Thermo-Trap Gel is non-toxic and contains water, harmless surfactants and inorganic based agents, prolonged use may cause dryness of the skin and may irritate the eyes if sprayed directly into them. Freezing: it is recommended that the product not be allowed to freeze. However, it is freeze-thaw stable. Once unfrozen, it will appear less viscous, but heat barrier will be unaffected.
